Advice for Liverpool Football Club supporters,
Liverpool FC v Napoli 17th September 2019
Kick Off 21:00 Local time



Liverpool Football Club appreciates the dedication and loyalty of our travelling fans. Below is general advice and information which you may find helpful when planning your trip.

Stadium Address: San Paolo Stadium - Piazzale Vincenzo Tecchio, 80125 Napoli NA, Italy

Important Information:

- Kick-off is at 21:00 CET (20.00hrs BST). Turnstiles will open at 18:00 (three hours before kick-off). Naples is one hour ahead of the UK (+1 BST).
- Liverpool FC supporters are advised not make their own route to the stadium due to risks to their personal safety.
- All travelling supporters should meet at Stazione Marittima, where a series of shuttle buses will be provided to and from the stadium (see below for more information). Supporters are advised to arrive in plenty of time at the shuttle bus meeting point to

facilitate searches and ticket checks. **NB: Please note this is subject to change at the discretion of the Italian Authorities - up to date information will be published by LFC and the FCO website. All supporters must continually check for updates to ensure they have the most accurate information.**

- Flags – if you are planning on taking flags with you, please send a picture of the flag and the fire certification to slo@liverpoolfc.com by Friday 13th September 2019. Any requests after this date will not be considered and flags will not be approved
- Supporters arriving in Naples prior to matchday should remain in their respective hotel to drink and eat.

Travel Advice:

- Supporters arriving in Naples prior to matchday should remain in their respective hotels to eat and drink.
- Supporters should not congregate (on mass) in public areas and should avoid becoming isolated in areas away from the port area of the city.
- Supporters are strongly advised not to wear club colours away from the port area
- Any fans wishing to visit the inner areas of Naples city should remain vigilant and be aware that they may be targeted for petty theft, robbery and assault.
- You are advised that all belts will be checked and any deemed to have an oversized buckle will be confiscated. Normal sized belts will be permitted



Fan Meeting Points:

- The Liverpool FC nominated fan meeting point will be at Stazione Marittima



Getting to the stadium

Supporters should not make their own way to the stadium due to risks to their personal safety. This is applicable even if your hotel is near the stadium. All travelling supporters should meet at Naples Marine terminal located at Molo Angioino, Stazione Marittima, 80133 no later than 15:30, where a series of busses to the stadium will be provided.

Transport to the stadium is free to all Liverpool supporters in possession of a valid match ticket. The buses provided by the local authorities for transporting visiting supporters will be accessible for wheelchair users.

All supporters using the shuttle bus are required to produce their tickets and identification with a corresponding name as that on the ticket. Any supporter with a ticket that is not in their name will not be allowed to travel to the stadium as it is an offence under Italian national legislation to attempt to enter a ground with a ticket not in your name.

Supporters with accessibility needs who are travelling to the stadium by car may park in Marconi Street.

If you wish to do so, please call us on 01512642500 and provide your vehicle registration number beforehand to guarantee access.

- Wheelchair users and supporters with access requirements can be dropped off in the designated visiting supporters drop-off area (see above diagram ("Visiting Stand")) and enter via a gate at entrance 26
- You are urged to arrive at the pre designated meeting point Stazione Marittima, Naples from 3pm at the latest
- The last coach/bus will leave at 1800 hours local time

- Transportation to the stadium in convoy with full police escort will be provided. We are advised that once two busses are full, they will leave. The busses capacity is 80/100 people standing.
- The time to reach the stadium is normally one hour but depends on traffic

As with last year's transport operation there are no toilet facilities on coaches/buses

At the Stadium:

Supporters will enter the stadium via Gate 26

- Gates will open from 18:00. Ticket check and searches will be in operation
- There will be Napoli stewards and police in our visiting section in addition to LFC stewards
- The facilities on the concourse are basic but adequate and include male and female toilets and a refreshment selling point. Sales are cash only and NO ALCOHOL will be served.
- The following items must be considered forbidden: bottles, cans or glass bins or any other materials (drinks have to be dispensed in plastic or paper glasses), umbrellas (except pocket-size), helmets, belts with heavy metal studs, sticks, soiling or pollutant material and any other object that could be used to injure and harm as decided in any specific time by the Police Authority in the Stadium. S.S. Calcio Napoli will not provide for any custody services of such objects. To introduce or show signs, banners, megaphones, drums, documents, pictures, disguise masks, printed materials and any kind of unauthorized banner, even if it does not contain any written content and in the case that it obstructs the visibility to other supporters or the emergency signs.

Post-Match

- We are advised that a hold back will be in operation to allow the immediate vicinity of the stadium to clear. This could take a minimum of 1 hour and will be announced via the stadium PA system announcement. We will ensure that you are able to exit the stadium as soon as possible, so that you may commence your return journey.
- During the hold back toilet facilities will be available to supporters but no refreshments.
- The coaches and buses used prior to the game will be parked in Marconi Street to transport supporters back to fan meeting point.
- There will be no organised onward transfer to the airport, however taxis will be available for supporters.

Information from Merseyside Police:

A team of Merseyside Police Officers will be operationally deployed overseas for the SCC Napoli v Liverpool FC football match being played in Napoli on 17th September 2019. The primary function of the team is to advise the local Police service and gather and disseminate information.

Supporter Liaison Officer (SLO)
