This information aims to help you prepare for your group's activity and outline the steps LFC take to ensure that these events always apply safe practices for all involved.

We will:

- Be inclusive and ensure that our activities include all members of the group as fully and equally as possible
- Create a positive environment
- Provide a unique LFC experience
- Provide a safe environment
- Provide an experience suited to your group's age, experience and abilities.
- Provide a trained, friendly, knowable and helpful LFC staff as appropriate to facilitating your experience
- When provided – equipment will be appropriate to the activity and of high quality and safety tested
- Comply with the appropriate guidelines and regulations in place relevant to the activities being undertaken (for example Premier League and Football Association safeguarding guidelines).

You will:

- Provide appropriate supervision to the age of the group throughout the activity
- Ensure supervision is adequate to the needs of the group and appropriate to the activity being undertaken
- Provide for and make arrangements to meet the welfare needs of the group. If you need information about facilities at an LFC site before your visit please do not hesitate to contact us
- Assess and provide appropriate adult supervision to child numbers based on age and abilities of group
- Ensure that those adults responsible for supervision within the group are able to manage any behavioral issues that might arise within the group
- Ensure you meet your H&S obligations for your group and the nature of their activity
- Ensure that you have in place the appropriate parent consents for the nature of the activity being carried out, including any permissions for photographs that may be taken of the group
