Price Notes

Concessionary priced tickets are available to over 65's and juniors aged 16 and under.

Young adult priced tickets are available to 17-21 year olds.

Junior tickets must be purchased with an adult ticket - a minimum of 1, or a maximum of 2 adults per junior is required.

Children 13 years and under must be accompanied by an adult.

Under 2s will not be permitted into the stadium.

Stadium Access

Liverpool FC will use digital ticketing for all fans to access the Carabao Cup final at Wembley.

Supporters will be required to download a one-off digital pass to their smartphone wallet to gain access to Wembley Stadium.

Digital Tickets

New for season 2024/25 - digital passes for this fixture can only be downloaded from the ticket section in your [My Account](#). **Each individual supporter must have completed Single Sign On to be able to log into their My Account to download their own ticket. Tickets will not be issued via email.**

Season Ticket and Membership NFC Passes WILL NOT be activated for stadium entry for this game.

Ticket Security

All tickets are strictly non-transferable and are not available to forward to other supporters.

Supporters are reminded to only purchase from official sellers and to be aware of fraudulent tickets online.

Screenshots of digital passes are not valid for stadium access and all reports of ticket touting, or online ticket fraud, will be investigated in line with the Liverpool FC [sanctions process](#). If a supporter has been found to have offered a ticket for sale online, this could result in a lifetime ban for that individual.

Waiting List

If any tickets are made available to supporters on the waiting list, they will be available to purchase online only, and on a first come first served basis until sold out.

Tickets will not be guaranteed and a queueing system will be in place.

The number of tickets made available to supporters on the waiting list will depend on the number of tickets remaining following the earlier sales.

As a reminder, the Club launched Single Sign On (SSO) on 18 November 24. From this date, the login details for all existing Ticketing accounts changed. Supporters must have completed SSO in order to purchase tickets. Click [here](#) for further details.

Travel And Parking at Wembley

Supporters are reminded that WNSL is a public transport venue with only limited on-site parking. Supporters are therefore encouraged to travel by public transport to the stadium. Please visit Wembley Stadium's [Getting to Wembley](#) webpage for more details.

Parking for supporters can be purchased in advance of the match, on-the-day purchase will not be available; please [visit](#).

Car parking is charged at £40.00 per space.

Coach/Minibus parking is charged at £120.00 per space.

Disabled Parking: Blue Badge parking is available to purchase at a cost of £25.00 per space; please [visit](#).

Shuttle Bus Service: An accessible transport facility is available from Wembley Park Station to the stadium. For further information please visit Wembley Stadium's Accessible Shuttle webpage or [visit](#).

Please note: Parking is subject to availability and may be subject to price increases on match day.

Safe Standing

Wembley operates standing areas at the rear of the three blocks behind the goal on Level 1.

These areas will be identified at point of sale. Additional entry restrictions and a code of conduct may be implemented to assist in the management of the standing areas. This may include:

- Ticket holders being required to occupy the space in front of the seat allocated to them on the ticket – supporters cannot migrate to different spaces within the section.
- Supporters who purchase in these areas must expect that other spectators will be standing.
- Sitting or standing on the barriers or standing on the seats will not be permitted.
- The minimum age requirement for these areas is 12 years old.
