

NON-MEMBERS - NFC MOBILE TICKET FOR ANDROID /GOOGLE

This guide explains how to add and use your match ticket on Android/Google smartphones.

PLEASE NOTE: NFC MATCH TICKETS MUST BE DOWNLOADED TO THE SMARTPHONE YOU INTEND TO USE TO ACCESS THE STADIUM ON MATCH DAY.

Fans will not gain entry using photographs or screenshots of NFC passes.

Fans will no longer gain entry to the stadium using the previous stadium access cards or barcoded tickets.

HOW TO ADD YOUR NFC PASS TO YOUR SMARTPHONE

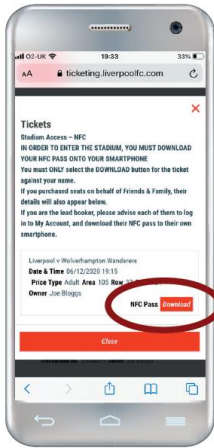
Please ensure the following are set up on your smartphone, before downloading your NFC pass:

- Google Pay
- Google Chrome
- NFC enabled - you can do this in 'Settings' on your phone, please refer to the user guide of your device.

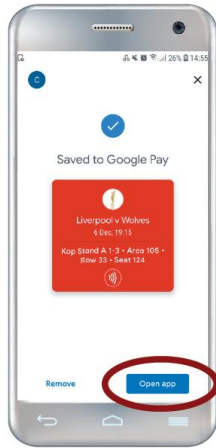
On your smartphone, open the 'Google Chrome' app and type ticketing.liverpoolfc.com in the search bar.

Log in to My Account, by clicking the icon at the top of your screen

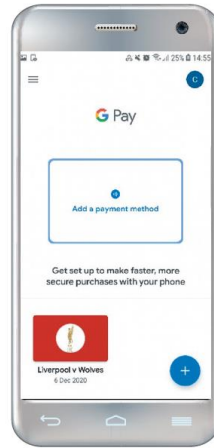
Once in My Account, select the 'Tickets option, and follow the instructions below to download the ticket to your smartphone:

CLICK OPEN APP



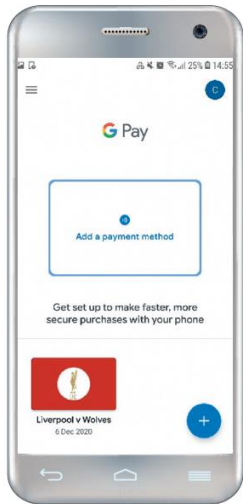
STEP 3

TO GOOGLE PAY



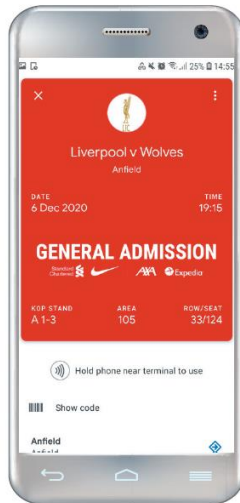
STEP 4

TAP THE READER

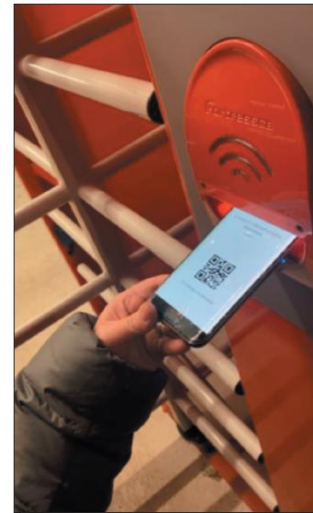
Alternatively, you can click 'show code' to display a barcode and the hold your smartphone on the reader.
